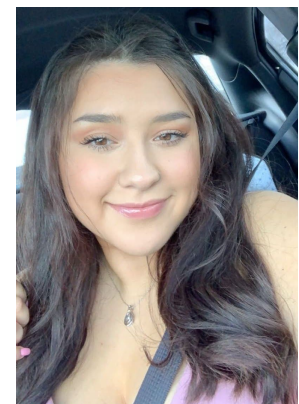
Jessica Rodriguez - Teacher
